**G**reetings from the Prescott Congregation,

We kicked off the fall season by hosting Pastor Martin Klok from the Netherlands for our bi-annual Youth Extreme Rally this past October. It was an exciting time, with 375 youth attending from across Arizona.

Pastor Klok preached an uplifting message, challenged the youth to be filled with the Spirit, and prayed with five young people who received the baptism of the Holy Ghost. Building on that momentum, we launched into an All-Day for Jesus outreach. As we went door-to-door, through parking lots, and into shopping centers. We witnessed a tremendous response with 40 decisions for Christ.

That evening, following the outreach, we presented our musical production "Super Fairy Tale." Featuring an all-youth cast and crew, the performance delivered everything it promised - from musical numbers with beloved princesses to an action-packed hero fight scene. The Gospel message came through powerfully, and at the altar call 10 people made decisions for Jesus Christ.

We then moved directly into revival with Pastor Klok, where we saw numerous miraculous physical healings and many timely words given each service. During the revival, 18 people were saved, and six were filled with the Holy Spirit. The Prescott congregation was refreshed and deeply encouraged. We are truly grateful for the ministry we received during these meetings.

As October continued, we held our annual Trunk or Treat outreach in the One80 Event Center parking lot. Many faithful saints decorated their trunks with creative themes, costumes, and passed out candy. We drew over 400 visitors, and we

saw 12 respond to the Gospel.

To close out the month, we hosted our annual Haunted House. Pastor Jesse Morales crafted an exciting theme titled "GRANNY," inspired by a popular online survival game among young people. This was an incredibly fruitful and exhilarating outreach for everyone involved.

# Life Transformed: Joel Morrison

My name is Joel Morrison. On May 18th, 1985 mercy, grace, truth, righteousness and unfailing love converged and I was in its center. The revelation of God's love became clear in the man, Jesus Christ.

The year 1972 found me as a pot smoking, beer drinking acid head. I had a love hate relationship with LSD, enjoying the hallucinogenic trips and wishing it was over at the same time.

I had the presence of mind to know this lifestyle was not sustainable. I needed to get away and learn a skill and planned to have the U. S. Air Force give me one. What they said I would learn and what they delivered on was a great deception to me. I wasn't there to serve in the military.

At my duty station I magically found like-minded partiers who also felt wrongly burned by Uncle Sam. We plotted schemes to exit the military without going AWOL. An idea my friend devised was tell-

ing our senior officers at the hanger of feeling mentally unstable. Since we worked around nuclear rockets they took this seriously.

For two weeks my friend visited a psychiatrist and wasn't allowed near the flight line. One day he returned to duty. He told me the shrink secretly recorded his counseling therapy and caught him contradicting his story. The doctor called his bluff and said to avoid charges he had better return to work. After a hallucinogenic New Year's Eve party my friend went AWOL.

I had to build some nerve before attempting the mental derangement route. My fiction was simple: my parents believed I was a failure so I rashly joined the service to run away, I couldn't adapt to that choice, but to return home a failure proved my parents point. It was a catch-22. I would sit in my open fourth story barracks window re-examining my situation over and over, pondering the fall to the ground, I told him. I was given an early and honorable discharge.

To celebrate the ruse a friend and I hit the ski slopes on acid. Right away I knew something was wrong. I just fell over and became a little man trapped inside my skull pounding on the windows of my eyeballs shouting for help at passersby. They just stared at the psycho writhing in the snow.

My pal returned me to the base and dumped me. I was in and out of

my head for days before being led by the hand through discharge and my flight home. I couldn't put five words together that made sense. My parents took me in and gave me a bed in the furthest corner of the basement where I hid most of the time. Mom worked for the county mental health clinic and knew something was wrong with her boy. I couldn't escape the insane, paranoid, uncontrollable thoughts that ricocheted in my mind, nor the pounding that came from somewhere.

Old friends would visit and try to pull me out of it. One day they told me, "you're not coming back." That remained the recurring theme for weeks - I wasn't coming back.

A eureka moment occurred to me. Underneath my dad's side of their bed was a pistol. That would provide the relief I needed. Of course, why didn't I think of that sooner? I stood and took one step and saw a clear vision of what I was happily about to do. I literally cried out in desperation, "Jesus! Make it stop!" I fell to my knees in a cold sweat. My chaotic thoughts left me and began turning into memories. The pounding departed.

It was going to take 12 years before I appreciated what had just happened. I went from there finding my old friends and began slipping towards that same life as before. I thought I again heard the pounding so I ran. I ran away from everything.

I became jaded and untrusting. I just wanted to be away from everybody and everything. My wife and I backpacked the West and mined for gold in California. That path led me to Prescott, Arizona. It was here that someone shared with me the good news of Jesus Christ. They said through him I could be born again, like starting from scratch.

That was more than 40 years ago. That is when I met the One who made it stop.

In September, we hosted our annual Bible Conference which was a monumental week for our church. The theme was "Raising Another Generation," and every single sermon was absolutely timely and powerfully on point. With sermons like "Middle Management Ministry," or "The Crisis of the Call," or "Don't Fumble the Bag," or "From Generation to Generation," every message was a challenge and inspiration for young people to rise up. All in all, we announced 20 new churches, six domestic, and 14 international. One notable announcement for us this year was the launching of our Door director (25) and his wife (23). Over the last 14 months (and long before any title as well), they served the church through the office of the Door directorship with great faithfulness, commitment, and heart.

As Pastor Torey Williams often tells us, "Your repetition becomes your reputation," and they surely lived up to that in terms of punctuality, attention to detail, and giving other young people the opportunity to serve and minister in greater capacities. They served our church at such a high standard, all while having four children. The example they left us has served as a reference point for our church, but particularly our young people.

We carried this momentum into our annual Halloween production, in which we presented a rendition of the films, Pirates of the Caribbean. Over the course of three nights, we saw 14 decisions made for Jesus Christ. The reason this meant so much to us not only as a church, but as a cast, was for a couple of different dynamics.

Earlier on in the summer, we began preparations to have an old

school type Hell House at our One80 building, being that Halloween was on a Friday this year. We had held a couple of meetings, planned event layouts and scenes, spoken to leaders, and cast, ect. Unfortunately, due to some factors involving our One80 building, we were forced to pivot and ultimately shift away from the idea of a Hell House this year. So we decided to do the pirates play, and in September we hit the ground running.

We began practicing every week, meeting 3-4 times a week with hours long practices, we were praying, contending. We fasted every Monday in

the month of October, just to contend and believe that people would get saved. So to see four to five hands go up every single night was an absolute answered prayer, and such a joy to our heart as a team. In light of our conference just weeks earlier, it is worth noting that 95 percent of our cast was under the age of 25. In the end, it was just another reminder that God is into soul saving operations.

On November 10, at about 3:30 in the afternoon, our beloved Mrs. Connie Campbell went home to be with Jesus. Pages of this Trumpet could be filled trying to share all the impact

that Connie Campbell had on countless people throughout not only our church, but the world.

Mrs. Connie got saved in 1970 in a small town, Creole Springs, Illinois. Shortly after, God dealt with her about fasting (skipping the last meal of the day), and praying the first hour of the day for her husband, Joe Campbell, to get saved. So essentially every day, from midnight to about one in the morning, she would go to the church down the road, and pray for Pastor Campbell. About one year later, in 1971, Pastor Campbell was radically converted and fully surrendered to Jesus.

The reality is that all that Pastor Campbell and Mrs. Connie accomplished in the Lord, was a fruit, in some way, of her conversion, but also her prayers 55 years ago. Things like celebrating 62 years of marriage (which they did earlier this year), seeing over 200-plus churches launched out of the Chandler wing, and other impact across the globe that cannot always be measured on paper, all of it, things that only heaven will reveal, a direct result of our beloved Mrs. Connie.

And through her passing, the spirit of our church has been one that wants to ensure we continue her legacy. As Pastor Greg Mitchell stated when discussing Pastor Wayman and Mrs. Nelda, they are never fully gone because the past lives in us.

We love Pastor Campbell and Connie, because just like Jesus, they first loved us, and served us for decades. We are so grateful here in Chandler, and so privileged to be a part of this Fellowship.

When we landed in Boston on August 14th, we stepped into a living tapestry of nations, languages, and cultures woven together on some of the oldest streets in America. Boston is a global crossroads - and a spiritual one - for the people we meet every day. The nations are not simply "out there." They are right here, walking past us on every corner.

People are open to talking about Jesus, and the city is hungry for the Gospel. Long before we arrived, God was already moving on hearts.

With no building, no signage, and no congregation, we did what our Fellowship has always done: we took the Gospel to the streets.

Bellingham Square, Orient Heights, bus stops, train stations - these places became our pulpit and altar. The city's heartbeat runs through its transit lines, so I preached in the flow of real life: commuters rushing to work, students heading home from class, families boarding the T.

And it was in those moments that God proved He was already working ahead of us.

One afternoon, as the Gospel echoed through the square, a young man heard the preaching from his apartment window. He followed the sound, came downstairs, and sat quietly on a bench. When the invitation was given, he responded for salvation. He began attending services, telling his friends and family what God had done in his life.

What began as one conversion quickly multiplied. In the first three months, God allowed us to witness 100 decisions for Christ. Dozens prayed for healing and deliverance.

One unforgettable moment happened in a parking lot. I approached a woman in a leg brace who was clearly in pain. I called a few people nearby to watch as we prayed. God touched her instantly. Those standing around were shocked as she lifted her hands and shouted praises to God all the way into the store.

God also gave us undeniable favor in finding a home. When the realtor showing our house learned we were moving from Prescott to start a church, he stopped, visibly surprised.

"Are you Christians - born again?" he asked. He then told us he had grown up just three houses down from Pastors Mark and Pe-



ter Aulson and had gone to school with people like Bruce Cutter, Kevin Foley, and many others who left Massachusetts during the Jesus People Movement to serve God in the Prescott church. In that moment, God opened a door of favor. We were approved for the house, and it instantly became the base for everything God would begin to do.

Our living room became a sanctuary. Cafés around the city became Bible study hubs. God brought people from every direction - some from the streets, some through conversations in shops, and students from the New England Conservatory of Music.

Boston real estate is among the most expensive in the nation, but every obstacle became an opportunity for God to show Himself strong. While searching for a permanent building, God moved on hearts across the city. Within weeks, we were offered four different locations at no cost to hold services.

Then God arranged something extraordinary. A couple offered us space to hold services on Beacon Hill, right in the heart of Boston. Favor opened a door we didn't even know to knock on. Doors unlocked. Hearts aligned. God placed His newborn church plant in the center of one of America's most historic and influential cities. Only God could orchestrate something like this.

In November, we celebrated another milestone: our first baptism

service. Three new believers publicly declared their faith in Christ. We had four first-time visitors, and three more people responded for salvation.

Boston is a city of ideas, history, and influence, but it is also a city in profound spiritual need. And God has placed a Potter's House church right in the center of it.

We are believing for revival. And we are believing that what God has begun, He will surely finish. We know this is only the beginning, and the best days are ahead.

There have been many testimonies of a renewed vitality and of refreshing in their walk with God. **Testimony**

My husband Shane and I grew up in church, and had the typical “church kid” experience.

We both made decisions at some point to serve God, and had glimpses of who He is, but we never had that true conversion experience. Both backslidden, Shane and I married in 2023, four years after the birth of our first son, Greyson. After the birth of our second son, Ezra, I returned to church and gave my life to Christ again, after much persistence from Greyson, who had regularly been attending church

with my mom. I began regularly attending church but was still lacking that real conversion experience. A few months later my husband began attending church during a revival, and shortly after that gave his life to Christ again. One major miracle that took place was with our son.

In July 2025, our son Ezra was scheduled for an eye procedure to repair a blocked tear duct present since birth, which caused daily discomfort, difficulty opening his eye in the morning, constant cleaning needs, skin irritation, as well as asthma, and ongoing GI issues requiring specialist care.

On the day of surgery, we arrived early at the hospital without cleaning his eye, met with the surgical team, and

20 minutes before the procedure, the anesthesiologist came to speak with us.

She asked for a summary of Ezra’s medical history and after hearing what we had to say informed us that she had been praying about Ezra’s case all morning and based on his medical history, she did not feel comfortable moving ahead with the procedure (this wasn’t a Christian facility).

We went home, relieved our son wasn’t having surgery but still not any closer to Ezra’s eye being fixed, or so we thought. We got home from the hospital, cleaned Ezra’s eye, and went about our day.

By that evening I realized I hadn’t had to clean his eye since returning from the hospital that morning.

The next morning it was still clear. My husband and we began closely watching each day to see if symptoms returned, and they never did. After a few days I finally called my Pastor to tell him that Ezra had been healed. Four months later, and he is still completely healed, along with his asthma!

My husband and I are blessed by the generational inheritance that has been invested in our church by our families. Each service there are four generations on my side and three generations on my husband’s

and three generations on my husband’s side, all in attendance. Our church and our Pastor are invaluable gifts that took us many years of rebellion against God to appreciate.

Since recommitting our lives to Christ, we have seen so many changes in ourselves and our lives. Our marriage has been placed on the solid foundation of God, when it was barely standing before. Our children are filled with joy, and have a sense of peace and security seeing their parents serve God and be transformed. God has made Himself

real to us in ways He never was before. He has provided job opportunities, blessed us financially, and answered so many prayers. We can confidently say for the first time that our trust is in God, because we know he will take care of us.

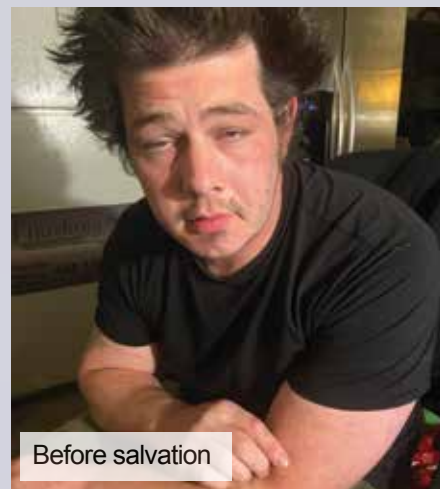

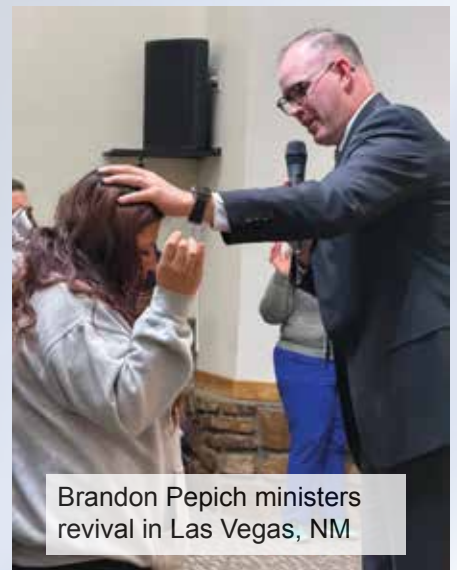

**G**reetings to all our Fellowship brethren! We are celebrating a wonderful fall harvest here in Tucson.

Over the last two months, more than 300 people have made decisions for Christ. During this time, 45 individuals have been baptized. At one baptism, we saw 20 visitors - people who had come to watch friends or family get baptized - respond to the altar call.

The Bible's prophets, including Jesus, made it very clear that moral decay would define society in the end times. We observe this happening in today's world. Yet, the Bible also predicts a great harvest in the last days, where “the plowman shall overtake the reaper,” and “Where sin abounded, grace abounded much more.” This grace was unmistakably evident to us here in Tucson. We had scheduled an evangelist named

Ross Johnston to conduct a rally at the University of Arizona. Pastor Warner believed Johnston's testimony would resonate with today's generation.

Johnston was conceived by artificial insemination and raised by two lesbian mothers. Growing up, Johnston had never attended church or learned about God or the Bible. However, he was invited to church at age 16, and stepping into a church for the first time, he experienced a radical conversion that day, eventually leading him to become an evangelist holding large rallies where many were converted. We initially scheduled Johnston for April, but due to a scheduling conflict, we rescheduled for September. Coincidentally, Charlie Kirk's assassination occurred on the Wednesday before Johnston was scheduled to speak. The timing was incredibly impactful, as approximately 175 people prayed to receive Jesus at our church's Sunday services and two University of Arizona rallies. We are praying and trusting for lasting momentum and impact from that weekend.

In October, we performed the drama "Las Puertas Del Cielo" entirely in Spanish. This gave a wonderful opportunity for our Spanish-speaking brothers and sisters to step up and showcase their acting talents. In two performances, 40 people committed their lives to Jesus.

Additionally, there is a notable pastoral transition. One of our missionary couples, German and Dora Gastelum, who pioneered a church in Cucuta, Colombia, are returning to Tucson and will be assisting in our Spanish ministry.

"My wife and I were launched into Cucuta, Colombia, during the 2019 Tucson conference. At the time, I was 73 years old and pastoring in Tijuana, Mexico, at the 4th church we had pioneered by the grace of God.

As we arrived, we began working for God in a place called Via Del Rosario, an area of Cucuta. The Lord granted us favor in every effort. However, in January 2020, the COVID-19 pandemic forced us underground, as all public activities were banned. Yet, with God's help, we continued outreach in every possible way, and the church was being established.

The migration of Venezuelans to Colombia and other nations was underway, and we were able to reach Colombian disciples and preach to thousands of Venezuelans, a people in great spiritual and economic need.

The Light House medical mission from Santa Monica, California, came, and as we partnered with them, we were able to provide medical aid and preach to thousands, and from that, the church was established. During our opening in March 2021, we had a full house with about 60 visitors and the medical team

present.

During the first three years, we started discipling couples and successfully launched two baby churches, one in Rubio, Venezuela, and another in Los Patios, Colombia. The Los Patios church still exists and is thriving today. The Rubio, Venezuela church is currently on hold due to political unrest and other issues. We envision launching ministries in that great country once a stable government is established.

We have handed the work over to Pastor Armando Peralta and his wife, Maribel, from Tucson. The congregation has warmly welcomed them, and we trust that the work will continue to prosper despite all the trials and needs.

Currently, my wife and I are grateful to serve at the mother church and support the Spanish ministry. My wife Dora and I, as we near our 80s, are blessed by the strength of the Holy Spirit. We are deeply thankful to our Lord Jesus, Pastor Harold Warner, the Tucson church, and this wonderful Fellowship for the grace to be simple servants doing extraordinary things for our GREAT GOD.

May God's grace continue to bless our Fellowship as we work together to reach the world for Jesus!

Our church is stirred for Jesus and God has been opening many doors, blessing us tremendously.

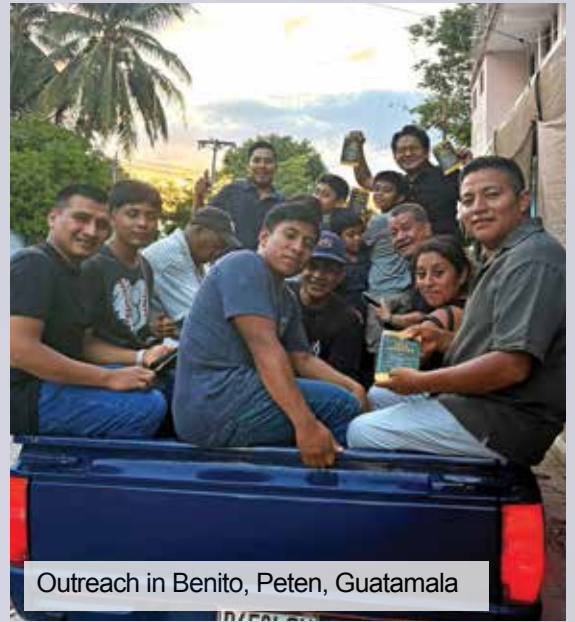
